Dear Members,

In accordance with regulations imposed on the Henderson-Nina Water System by USDA Rural Development, it is the duty of the Board of Directors to require that residential water users own an individual meter service. This rule is also a part of our water system bylaws as stated below:

ARTICLE XI

Section 4: Each member shall be entitled to service lines in excess of one basic service line for the purpose of serving the needs of the persons residing within a **single farmstead or dwelling** and of the livestock owned by such persons and to irrigate a garden etc....

Although this requirement has been in effect since the system was initially organized, some residential water users have more than one residence connected to an individual meter service. In an effort to remediate past practices, comply with the USDA requirement and make affordable to its customers, the Board of Directors recently adopted the following:

Upon motion by Perry Serrette, duly seconded by Barry Latiolais, to give Ray Robin, System Manager the authority to install new individual meter services for members who currently have dual residential connections and allow those individual customers to pay for regular water service fees plus an additional \$12.00 per month for 18 months in order to cover the cost of materials and the meter deposit, motion carried unanimously.

The customer will be issued a membership certificate after the 18 monthly payments, totaling \$216, has been collected.

Any member who currently has a water meter connected to more than one residence should contact Ray Robin at 228-7458 so arrangements can be made for the installation of separate water meters.
